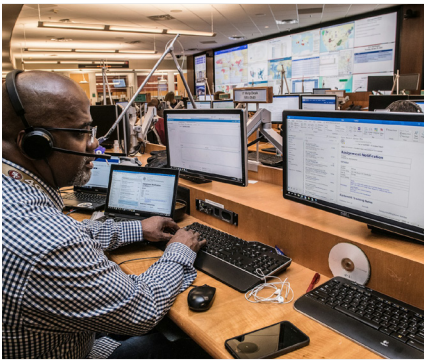

Florida's mid-market ops still run on a mix of paper trails, half-integrated tech, & plenty of underleveraged data. The real drag isn't strategy. In reality, it's the friction between old tools & new expectations.



Snapshot: The Busy I-4 Corridor

A look into the future of Florida

If you want to understand Florida's economic stress test, start here. What happens along the I-4 Corridor isn't isolated. It's predictive of the state's future.

Florida's Pressure Gauge

The I-4 corridor stretches 140 miles from Tampa Bay to Daytona Beach, connecting some of the state's fastest-growing areas & housing over a third of its population. Touching every facet of Florida's converging economy from distribution, tourism, housing, tech, labor, I-4 may not define the state, but it often sets the tempo.

In Lakeland, last-mile warehouse space is maxed out while service jobs lag behind soaring home prices. In Orlando, hospitality wages can't keep up with the price of traffic, let alone housing, forcing many workers into 90min commutes. In smaller cities like DeLand & Plant City, land is rapidly being snapped up by developers betting on regional logistics over local need. Tampa tech pushes on aging

utility grids while freight backups near I-75 delay everything from food to pharmaceuticals. These aren't just local headaches. For Florida, they're indicators of a system stretched thin.

I-4 is also more than a transportation artery — it's a proving ground for change in Florida. Here, booming tourism, logistics, & core sectors compete with infrastructure strain, housing shortages, & weather risks. The corridor's mix of high-growth opportunity & chronic bottlenecks exemplifies the tensions in our broader economy. A single storm, zoning shift, or policy tweak here can ripple statewide & with elections often decided in this area, it's where policy meets pavement. To understand how Florida manages its growing pains, watch this corridor. Today, it's the state's pressure gauge.

Document Your Processes Like Software Engineers

Operations should scale, not sit still
